April Lee is a Wayne County Parent Mentor. She recognized that her County has a need for more post-secondary options for those transitioning out of high school. She did some research and found a project, [We Grow Dreams](#), started by a group of parents in Chicago.

Motivated by this idea, she is working on developing a greenhouse project to teach skills and provide employment options for school leavers. The mission of this Transition/Greenhouse project is to provide people with disabilities the opportunity to lead fulfilling lives and to train and work in a supportive, safe and caring environment while producing and providing products and services to the community.



A collaborative effort will create employment for 15 to 20 adults with disabilities. Participants will be active in their community, contributing to the economy of Wayne County, and finding purpose and joy in everyday life.

April says: “We have a big problem when it comes to options for these wonderful people, but they do not lack dreams, and neither do their families.” April’s initiative is helping to turn those dreams into reality.

The Wayne County Transition/Greenhouse Project is scheduled to start in spring of 2011.
